An exercise in style. This is how **Haider Ackermann** defines Opium, a Carte Blanche collection marking the debut of the French designer's menswear collection. A show that hit the runway in June during Pitti at Palazzo Corsini, a few steps away from the banks of the river Arno. Inspired by the Palazzo itself and by great Italians of the past as Visconti and Zeffirelli, the designer created a collection dedicated to the romantic idea of a woman who travels with her man. Ackermann's intent is to dream with whoever observes his creations.

The designer imagines a gypsy man, and the atmosphere of the Marroccan souks and of the desolated desert are palpable through out the garments. Everything flows: sumptuous silks, embroidered fabrics, gray and black meet the color palette of precious gems. Ackermann presents his collection to **Maria Luisa Pommaillou** through an exclusive interview on thecorner.com, multi-brand online store launched by the Yoox group in 2008.
